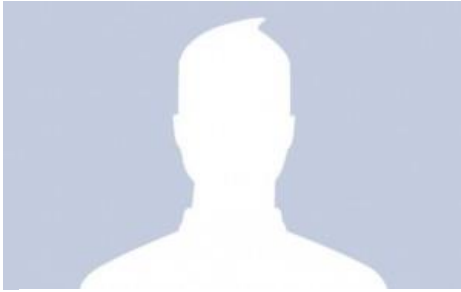


Herbert Spann
